Itinerary

October 24 - New York - Casablanca

Depart New York on Royal Air Maroc, non-stop flight to Casablanca.

October 25 - Arrive Casablanca

You will be met by your Moroccan Tour Guide, and then driven to Tabat, the capital of Morocco. You will check into your hotel and may choose your location for lunch.

Afternoon tours will include walking to the bustling Medina, a visit to the Kasbah of the Oudayas, the Great Mosque, the Hassan Tower, the magnificent Mohammed V Mausoleum, and drive past the Royal Palace.

Breakfast, Dinner

October 26 - Moulay Idriss/Meknes/Fez

This morning you will continue your exploration of the Imperial Cities with a stop at Moulay Idriss, the Holiest city of Morocco. Then on to the archaeological site of the roman ruins at Volubilis where you will have time to walk around and explore the ruins with a local guide. After your break for lunch, a drive through the numerous gates of Meknes. Visit the famous Gate of Bab el Mansour, Dar Jamai Palace, and the Royal Stables. Your day will end in Fez, the first Imperial City built in 790 A.D. by Moulay Idriss II.

Breakfast, Dinner

October 27 - Fez

A full day to explore Morocco's most fascinating city, which is the world's oldest and last surviving Medieval city. Start by traveling downtown to visit the King's Palace. This will take you on a walk through the Jewish and Arab section to the South King Palace, and then continue along the river for panoramic view of the Old Town Medina. You enter the city through one of the main gates for a walking tour highlighting the Karaouine University (the oldest university in the world), the Mederssa Attarine, Bouanania

Religious School, Nejarine Fountain, and the medina of Fez el-Bali. Then visit the Moulay Idriss Mausoleum and a famous tannery where skins are cured and dyed in enormous vats. Dinner with local family this evening.

Breakfast, Dinner

October 28 - Marrakech

Depart early this morning and travel through the Middle Atlas region of Imouzer du Kandar and several Berber villages. Visit the ski resort of Ifrane and the Berber village of Azrou, which is noted for its handicrafts and carpet weaving. Today's drive takes us through forests and beautiful mountainous areas. You will be treated to lunch in the city of Beni Mellal.

October 29 - Marrakech

After breakfast, you will have a full day of sightseeing in Marrakech. You will visit the Saadian Tombs, Dar Si said Palace Museum, Agdal, and Menara Gardens. At the ruins of El Badi Palace you will see the tanners and dyers quarters. After lunch you will visit the D'Jemaa el Fna Square, a spectacular open theater atmosphere with storytellers, soothsayers, snake charmers, and fire-eaters. Dinner will be at the Chez Ali with Fantasia Show.

October 30 - Casablanca

You will enjoy today's drive to Casablanca. The drive will give you time to reflect on your amazing journey in Morocco, and you will most probably be planning your next trip back to see more of this unique and special country. Sightseeing in Casablanca includes United Nations Square, Royal Palace, Central Market and Anfa Residential area. A visit to the Hassan II Mosque, which is the second largest Mosque in the Moslem world, is a great way to end your day.
